Our society is looking forward to this years S/W Regional Show & Conference being held in Canberra in September. A design committee has been formed to plan our 2m x 2m floor display for this event.





#### **Show Schedules**




# We Aussies are Tough Lynne Phelan

This is a story of orchid resilience. Many years ago, probably 15-20, I tucked a small plant of the Australian native Cymbidium madidum in behind an elkhorn fern which was growing on a banksia tree in our backyard. In time, it and the fern grew happily and the madidum flowered regularly. Sadly, in 2023 the banksia died and, without protection from its foliage, the fern and the west-facing madidum were going to be fully exposed to the full force of the sun. In August the decision was made to move them so the dead tree could be removed. By this stage the elk fern had totally encircled the tree trunk at head height and the madidum had grown into a huge specimen. Saws, crowbars and brute strength were needed but eventually the job was done. The huge madidum was divided into two really large plants and potted up while a few backbulbs were put in an empty pot and hung on the verandah where they were misted almost every day as I did my watering. On 15 February, 2025 I noticed a couple of green shoots and a tiny flower spike which opened in March. Still no roots so I'm not sure if they will survive.
